Skilled DIGITAL MULTIMEDIA Volunteer Support Roles

This is an exciting opportunity over the summer, for suitable persons seeking to make a key and lasting contribution across Ireland with a new faith-focused organisation.

As a new startup organisation in Ireland, we're looking for creatives to help us create good quality media as a **photographer**; **videographer** or **graphic designer**.

Below is an outline of these important volunteer roles, now open to suitable candidates:

1. **Photographer and a videographer** to cover key CAP publicity events coming up:
 1. CAP presence at New Wine (Christian conference) in Sligo 13Jul23 incl seminars and stand etc. morning and afternoon
 2. Public launch in a Dublin-city church venue 21Sep23 at both afternoon & evening launch events
 3. Delivering church talks etc. on dates TBD but likely to be on Sunday mornings/evenings or mid-week in the greater-Dublin area initially
2. **Graphic designer** to help create localised CAP IRL marketing and communications materials based on CAP UK templates and branding guidelines incl:
 1. Letterhead (print and digital versions)
 2. Business cards (printer ready)
 3. Pull-up banners (printer ready)
 4. Church Partnership info packs (both printer and downloadable digital versions for our website)
 5. moneycoaching course materials (both print and digital versions) aimed at different audiences like participants; coaches and befrienders etc.

While the above volunteer role descriptions are indicative only, we're confident that we can fit these roles in around an individual's week-to-week personal circumstances or professional full-time role. Might even suit someone who's currently out of the work force or taking time out, but keen to keep their skills up to date.

These are volunteer roles that CAP IRL does not have the budget to fund and so no paid staff to cover these roles. We are able to cover expenses associated with travel and any entrance fees, like to New Wine, while volunteering.
