Skilled moneycoaching programme STEERING TEAM volunteer

This is an exciting opportunity over the summer, for suitable persons seeking to make a key and lasting contribution across Ireland with a new faith-focused organisation.

As a new startup organisation in Ireland, we're researching and localising adult learning resources aimed at enhancing individual financial capability and well being. We're looking for **several volunteers to be part of a collaborative steering team**, developing our new moneycoaching educational programme, to be delivered with our Church Partners.

Below is an outline **description of this role**, now open to suitable candidates:

1. Working with the CEO and some of the Board of Directors (listed below)
2. Initially a few hours per week Jun-Jul picking up Aug-Sep this year
3. Helping to localise the moneycoaching course currently under development with CAP UK
4. Researching how best CAP's programme can "signpost" to established financial supports like MABS and PIPs to our programme participants
5. Developing how best our volunteer coaches can "triage" the financial circumstances of participants especially those affected by problem debt
6. Developing how best our volunteer befrienders can journey alongside those affected by problem debt and in some kind of formal resolution process
7. Best way of documenting, presenting and hosting the programme at a local community level that's easily accessible to a wide range of audiences in IRL
8. Best way of training and developing local church-based volunteers to host and deliver the programme over a 1-2 year time frame

Skills and experiences for this role incl the following:

- Financial and money management preferably within an adult learning context
- Good people person and a strong yet concise communicator in writing
- Detailed and analytical person able to see things from more than one angle
- Comfortable working to a timetable and collaboratively on Zoom etc. while in a way that works for you and under your own initiative

While the above volunteer role description is indicative only, it can be split into parts to fit in around an individual's week-to-week personal circumstances or professional full-time role. Might even suit someone who's currently out of the work force or taking time out, but keen to keep their skills up to date.

This is a volunteer role that CAP IRL does not have the budget to fund and so no paid staff to cover the role. We are able to cover expenses and sundry costs agreed in advance, while volunteering for CAP.
